Oklahoma's Tenkiller State Park, located near the dam of scenic Lake Tenkiller, offers vacationers a wonderful diversion of natural wonder and magnificent beauty.

Tenkiller Park is a recreation mecca. With some 1,190 acres in Oklahoma's Green Country, the park has facilities available for everything from hiking to scuba diving to boating and fishing. The scenery, especially around the wooded lake area, is breathtaking. The magnificent limestone cliffs that are found within the park have enchanted visitors from all around the world.

Lake Tenkiller is one of Oklahoma's most beautiful reservoirs. This 12,650 acre recreational paradise was formed in the 1950's with the construction of the Tenkiller Ferry Dam across the Illinois River (the dam is Oklahoma's second largest at 197 ft.)

Location

Tenkiller State Park is located in eastern Oklahoma. From Westbound I-40 take The Vian Exit, North 8 Miles On SH 82, then left 4 miles On SH 100. From Eastbound I-40 take The Gore Exit 287, then North On SH 100 To Park.

RULES AND REGULATIONS TO REMEMBER

- Please do not litter.
- Quiet hours are 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- All pets must be caged or on a leash not to exceed 10 feet.
- 14-day camping limit.
- All overnight camping is subject to fee.
- Park in designated areas only.
- Collecting firewood, nuts and berries, disturbing plants and animals or other natural features is strictly prohibited.
- It is unlawful to dump water, sewage or effluent (grey water) from sinks, upon or into the surface of the ground or water.
- Glass containers prohibited in swimming areas.
- Curfew, 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., fishing, camping and boating only.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Cabins

Tenkiller State Park has 39 cabins for rent. There are 10 courtyard cottages that sleep two people and 22 one-bedroom cabins that sleep up to four, 16 two-bedroom cabins that sleep six and one three bedroom cabin sleeps 10. Fourteen of the two bedroom and 10 of the one-bedroom cabins are equipped with fireplaces. Cabins feature living areas as well as kitchens equipped with cookware, dishes, etc. The cabins are of the housekeeping type and cleaning supplies are provided. Cabins do not have telephones. There are also 4 shelters for rent.

Group Camp

There are no group camp facilities at Tenkiller, although a community building, seating up to 100 people, is available for rent. The building has central heat and air, but no kitchen facilities.
